Location and Parking

Awards

First day: All marks will be posted throughout the day.

Second day: Both scores from Friday and Saturday will be combined. All Awards and Prizes will be handed out.

Rules

The SCA Rule Book defines the competitive rules and divisions for Pom - www.sca.ca. The SCA Rule Book defines the competitive divisions for School stunt (based on USASF/IASF Cheer Divisions) and refers to the USASF/IASF Cheer Divisions for All-Star competitive divisions and to the USASF/IASF Safety Rules for competitive rules for School and All-Star stunt divisions - www.sca.ca and www.usasf.net. The SCA will be using Cheer Canada's score sheets and judging methodology - www.cheeercanaca.net.

Performance Area

All team divisions will perform on a sprung floor measuring 42' (front to back) x 54' (side to side).

Warm Up

Assigned Warm-up times will be available prior to the event. Tumbling warm ups will be available on the performance area.

Music

All teams must provide their own music either on MP3 or CD. CDs must be labelled with the school/team name and category/division. A sound system will be provided. A back-up CD will be available and present at the time of performance. Speed control is not available. Music checks on the main sound system are not permitted. A representative must be present at the sound system at the time of performance. Advisors/coaches are asked to hold onto their own music until the time of performance and to take music back following the performance.

Schedule of Events

A more detailed schedule will be sent out a later date. Please note that the Friday start is schedule to be around 4pm.

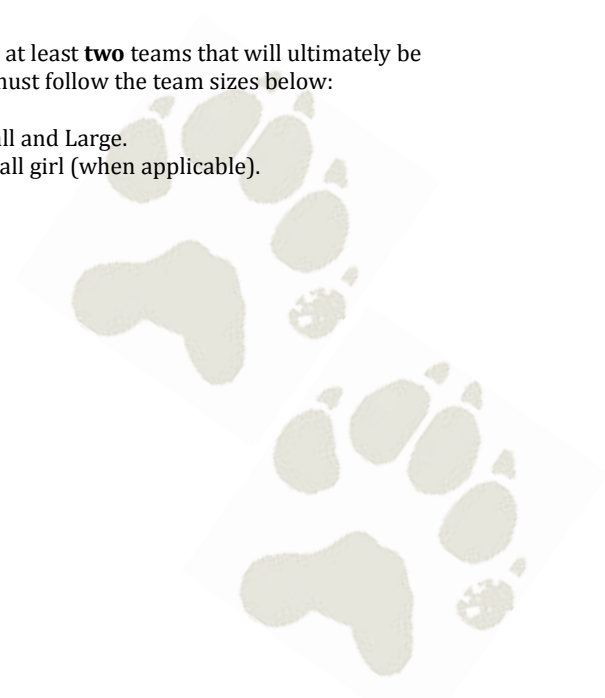
SMALL/LARGE SPLITS
