Welcome to a new year! The 2009-2010 season promises to be exciting and educational with judging certification held in Regina and Saskatoon, a Coaches' Conference being held in Regina on September 26th, an informative website ([www.sca.ca](http://www.sca.ca)), and blanket insurance for all our regular members.

As a school or club, you have the ability to purchase a regular membership, which gives you membership rights and voting privileges. Each school/club may purchase up to two regular memberships each year. The benefits of purchasing two memberships include a stronger voice within the SCA and the privilege of two votes at the Annual General Meeting. Schools/clubs also have the opportunity to purchase one, two, or three-year memberships for convenience. The fees are as follows:

1 Year Membership:	Single (\$80)	Double (\$150)
2 Year Membership:	Single (\$160)	Double (\$300)
3 Year Membership:	Single (\$240)	Double (\$450)

- Obtain the right to vote on rule changes and other motions (regular membership only).
- Obtain the right to vote on the executive election (regular membership only).
- Obtain the ability to run for an executive position.
- **Obtain access to the SCA Saskatchewan Provincial Cheerleading Championship on Saturday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at Marion Graham Collegiate in Saskatoon.**
- Obtain a subscription to the Liberty Post, SCA's own informative e-newsletter.

Some items to point out for this year:

- **The SCA has decided to get blanket insurance for all of our members.** We are currently finalizing all of the details. It will cost \$5.00 per member. We will require each athlete to fill out a waiver form and insurance form and pay this small fee for coverage.
- **The 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Coaches Conference will be held on Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup> in Regina,** (location to be announced). Thanks to your feedback from the past conference, we have scheduled it earlier in the season.
