If you decide to host a SCA-sanctioned competition, we will take care of all judging sheets, secure SCA Certified Judges and provide assistance to ensure a successful event!
- **Obtain access to the SCA Saskatchewan Provincial Cheerleading Championship on Saturday, March 24th in Saskatoon.**
- Access to the SCA Judging Program and chance to become a SCA Certified Judge.
- Resources for coaches through clinics and the knowledge base of our executive.
- Obtain the right to vote on rule changes and other motions (regular membership only).
- Obtain the right to vote on the executive election (regular membership only).
- Obtain the ability to run for an executive position.
- Obtain a subscription to the Liberty Post, SCA's own informative e-newsletter.
- Obtain the option to have a team biography and picture posted on our website: www.sca.ca.
- Become a voice within the SCA to promote your ideas, opinions, and motions.
